1. Preamble:

Engineers need to be specialists in their fields, but they also require competencies in other areas, this would include a grasp of basic financial awareness in order to manage finances, and budgets and appreciate core financial principles.

A two day's course being proposed will provide practical, interactive discussions designed to support individuals understanding of the key financial accounting and management accounting skills for understanding and interpretation of financial statements. - i) Budget and practical budgeting process
- ii) Linking budget to strategic objectives and good governance
- iii) Using management accounts to understand the past and forecast the future
- iv) Distinguishing between fixed and variable costs
- v) Understanding the concepts of break-even analysis
- vi) Cost centers, profit center and investment center Versus Strategic Business Units
- vii) Accounting for decision making and evaluation opportunity costs
- viii) Application of accounting knowledge for Engineers and other fields.
